

## INTRODUCING THE LTHS PTSA GRADUATION CORD PROGRAM!

Beginning with the Class of 2024, all LTHS students will have the opportunity to earn a graduation cord from our Lebanon Trail PTSA (Parent Teacher Student Association).

The honor cord is a long-standing tradition of recognizing and celebrating students in high schools and colleges. At the high school level, graduation cords symbolize accomplishments such as academic excellence, leadership skills, community service, and contributions to extracurricular activities. The cord is an entwined rope with a tassel attached to each end, and is worn around the neck on top of the graduation gown.

The LTHS PTSA cord color will be emerald green which symbolizes community service through volunteering with our PTSA to engage all students in partnership with parents and teachers to support and improve the LT community.

For the classes of 2024, 2025, and 2026, a graduated point system is in place to enable you to earn a graduation cord starting with your current grade:

Class of 2024: **15 points** Class of 2025: **30 points** Class of 2026: **45 points** Class of 2027 & beyond: **60 points**

## GRADUATION CORD PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

## LTHS students must earn 60 points by March 31st their senior year.

PTSA Membership* (JoinPTA.org)	5 points	per year of membership
Reflections Entry	5 points	per year (max 1/year)
PTSA Approved Community Service**	1 point	per hour (max 20 pts/year)
Attend PTSA General Meeting	5 points	per meeting
Serving on PTSA Executive Board	5 points	per year

- All activities must be confirmed and approved by the LTHS PTSA Board.
- Submit your online form every year by the last day of the school year.
- SENIORS must submit their online cord reporting form by March 31st
- Must be a PTSA member no later than March 31st of senior year. (Membership scholarships available)
- \* Must be a PTSA member no later than March 31st of senior year.
- \*\* Community Service can include assisting with PTA projects, working PTSA booths and events, and other hours accepted on a case-by-case basis (pre-approval required). PTSA and PTA hours count as FISD hours.
- Exceptions will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
